

The functions under the Criminal Injuries Compensation (Northern Ireland) Order 2002 which are now the responsibility of the Secretary of State for Justice are:

- Article 7(1)(b) Appointment of adjudicators
- Article 7(2)(b) Appointment of the Chairman
- Article 7(3)(a) Power to determine the terms of employment for the adjudicators (the power to determine terms of appeals staff will continue to rest with the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland)
- Article 7(6) Removal of adjudicators from office
- Article 8(1) Requirement to make annual report to Parliament in respect of the appeals system
- Article 8(2)(a) and (4) Appointment of a person to make an annual report and provide accounts on the appeals system (Accounting Officer)
- Article 8(3) Requirement to lay before Parliament copy annual report in respect of the appeals system
- Article 8(5) Requirement to send to the Comptroller and Auditor General copy of accounts relating to the appeals system
- Article 13(1) Power to remunerate adjudicators
- Article 13(2) Power to pay compensation to adjudicators for loss of office
- Article 13(3) Power to remunerate the Chairman of the CICAPNI (Appeals staff continue to be remunerated by the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland)
