



“I’ve received a Notice of Intention to Enforce a Non-Money Judgment”

“What does this mean?”

- The creditor has been awarded a court order to recover land, property, or goods from you.
- They are intending to enforce the order through the Enforcement of Judgments Office.

“What can I do now?”

- You give the land, property, or goods on the court order back to the creditor within 10 days and the matter will go no further
- Contact the creditor to find out if a suitable arrangement can be reached. If an arrangement is made enforcement action can be put on hold

“What can happen next?”

- If the court order is for repossession of your house you can be evicted
- If the court order is for repossession of land, the land on the court order can be taken from you
- If the court order is for repossession of goods, the goods on the court order can be taken from you
