Summary

During Apr - Jun 2010:

Chancery

There were 1,828 cases received into the Chancery division. In total, 57% were chancery cases, 34% were bankruptcy cases and 9% were companies' cases. There were 1,548 cases disposed of during the reporting period.

Queen's Bench

There were 1,891 writs received in Queen's Bench (Fig 1). Of those, 47% were negligence cases. There were 266 default judgments, 357 office disposals and 766 court disposals for writs during the quarter. There were 196 removals and remittals applications dealt with.

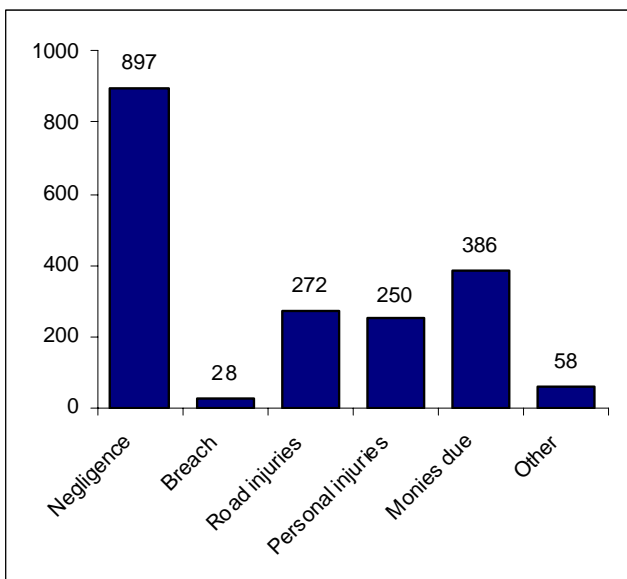
Judicial Reviews

There were 72 applications for leave to apply for Judicial Review and 26 applications for Judicial Review received during the quarter.

Probate

There were 1,726 grants issued during the quarter in the probate office.

Wardship and Adoption

There were 34 adoption applications received and 30 adoption applications disposed of during the quarter. It took, on average, 40 weeks for an adoption application to progress through the courts.

Matrimonial

There were 681 divorce petitions lodged in the High Court. Of these, 425 petitions were lodged by the wife. In total, 429 decrees nisi and 263 absolutes were issued.

Patients

There were 222 new referrals in the Patients section.

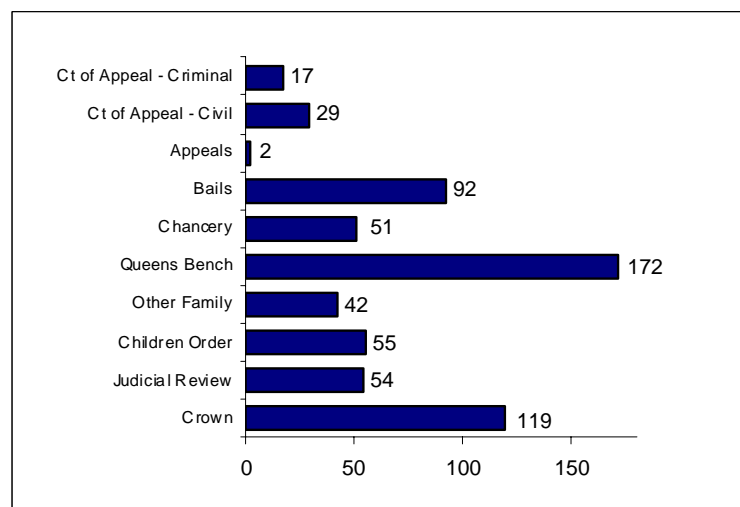
Official Solicitors
